Yakima Folklife Festival, Saturday & Sunday, July 9-11, 2010

The Yakima Folklife Association cordially invites you to send in your application for space at this year's festival. Festival crafts will be juried this year to assure quality and avoid over saturation of any type of craft. Items being sold by agents, such as imported crafts, will be allowed except when they are in direct competition with like items sold by the maker.

Booth spaces are 10' x 10'. The fee per booth is \$50.00 per day.

You must supply your own booth. We recommend you bring your own shade (awning or umbrella). Electricity is not provided. All booths will be in the open air, in Franklin Park behind the Yakima Valley Museum (2105 Tieton Drive, Yakima). Assigned craft booth locations will be marked out beforehand. Please let us know if you have any special needs or requests ahead of time.

NO PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ON GRASS AT ANY TIME this is a Yakima city park, and it is their policy. If we don't follow the city park policy, we won't be allowed to use the park for future festivals.
